

Day 01: Haridwar to Barkot, Barkot to Yamunotri Dham and Barkot Stay

Day 02: Barkot to Uttarkashi, Gangotri Dham Darshan and Uttarkashi Stay

Day 03: Uttarkashi to Guptkashi Stay



Day 04: Drop to Sonprayag, Departure towards Kedarnath

Dham (Self) & Camp Stay In Kedarnath with Dinner

Day 05: Kedarnath Return to Guptkashi and Stay

Day 06: Guptkashi to Badrinath Dham

Day 07: Badrinath to Haridwar and Drop









DAY 1: HARIDWAR TO YAMUNOTRI

Haridwar to Barkot (Drive - 180 km, approx. 7-8 hours)

- Early Morning start your journey to Barkot from Haridwar/Dehradun.
- Reach Barkot & Proceed to Janki Chatti by road.
- Start your trek to Yamunotri Dham.
- Visit Yamunotri Temple and offer prayers.
- Return to Barkot.
- Dinner and overnight stay at Barkot.





After reaching Barkot drive towards Janki Chatti. On arrival, begin 6 Km trek to Yamunotri. Once you reach, visit the main Yamunotri temple for Darshan; and seek the blessings of Goddess Yamuna Ji. After paying homage, trek back to Janki Chatti. From here, drive back to Barkot. Dinner & Overnight Stay in Hotel.

Yamunotriis a sacred place as the origin place of The River Yamuna. One of four sacred pilgrims of Uttarakhand. It is located at the north of Uttarkashi district in Uttarakhand. The temple was built by Amar Singh Thapa, Gurkha general in 18th century. Later the temple was damaged & renovated by Maharani Guleria of Jaipur in the 19th century. The source of Yamuna River lies in the Yamunotri Glacier which is at a height of 6,387 metres (20,955 ft) near the Bandarpunch peaks.
















DAY 2: BARKOT TO GANGOTRI

(Drive-200Kms/07 Hrs approx)

- After breakfast, check-out from the hotel.
- Drive to Uttarkashi, a picturesque town on the banks of the Bhagirathi River.
- Proceed to Gangotri Dham.
- Visit Gangotri Temple and take a holy dip in the sacred Ganges.
- Visit Gangotri Temple and other local attractions.
- Explore the beautiful surroundings and scenic vistas.
- Check-in at the hotel.
- Dinner and overnight stay at Uttarkashi.
- Return to Uttarkashi.
- Dinner and overnight stay at Uttarkashi.


















In the morning after an early breakfast, drive towards Gangotri. Upon arrival, take a holy dip in the river Ganges & offer prayer to the Goddess Ganges. After Darshan, drive back to Uttarkashi. Dinner & overnight •"The holy Gangotri temple is located at this sacred town. It is believed that at this place River Ganges descended on the earth after severe penance of King Bhagirathi. The Gangotri Temple was built by the Gurkha general Amar Singh Thapa in early 18th century. The Ganges originates from Gaumakh which is accessible after 19 Kms trek from Gangotri. During winters temple remain inaccessible due to heavy snowfall so the statue of Goddess Ganges is brought down to Mukhba, a small village in Harsilwhich lies on the way to the Gangotri Shrine." stay at the hotel.











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DAY 3: GANGOTRI TO GUPTKASHI

(Drive-295Kms/10 Hrs approx)

After breakfast drive towards Guptkashi. Upon arrival check in at the hotel. Dinner &overnight stay at the hotel.



DAY 4: GUPTKASHI TO KEDARNATH

(Drive-30Kms/02 Hrs approx)
Gaurikund to Kedarnath (22 Kms trek-one way)

Start the drive at 05:30 hr sharp to Gaurikund.

Sonprayag to Gaurikund distance is of 06Kms. Private Vehicles are allowed only till Sonprayag.

(Hire the local vehicle from Sonprayag to Gaurikund)

Upon arrival start the trek on the zigzag and well laid trail to Kedarnath there are other options of Ponny and Porterts also Palki to Reach Kedarnath

On arrival check-in at hotel, freshen up and visit KedarnathJi. Pay homage to divine statue of Nandi located at the temple entrance gate.





Attend the evening Arti and offer your prayers to Lord

You can also visit Adi Shankaracharya Samadhi, the grave of Adi Guru Shankaracharya, located at the premises of Kedarnath temple which is also one of the most popular spot at Kedarnath. After offering prayers get back to hotel for an overnight stay.

Kedarnath Dham is one of the pre-eminent divine temple of Lord Shiva. Temple is situated in a breathtaking location, near the source of Mandakini River. Kedarnath temple is highest located among the 12 Jyotirlingas and is also the most important temple among the Panch Kedars (group of five Shiva temples in Garhwal Himalayas)


















DAY 5: KEDARNATH TO GUPTKASHI

(Drive -120 Kms/05 Hrsapprox.)

In the morning participate the arti at and abhishek at Kedarnath temple & take blessing from Kedarnathji. Latter after breakfast trek down to same way where you come from. On arrival GaurikundDrive to Guptkashiand check into a hotel followed by dinner & overnight stay.



DAY 6: GUPTKASHI TO BADRINATH

(Drive -150 Kms/07 Hrsapprox.)

In the morning, after breakfast drive to the holy shrine of Shri Badrinath Ji. There are various temples on the way like the Vasudev temple, Vandevitemple, Gurudwara Sahib, Garur Ganga temple, Hanuman temple, Ekadashi Gufa. Upon arrival at Badrinath, check in at the hotel. Freshen up and visit Shri Badrinath ji. Take a holy dip in Tapt Kund, followed by a visit to the main temple for Darshan and to seek the blessings of Shri Badrinath Ji. After the visit take some rest. In the evening you can visit the shrine for Arti Darshan. Overnight stay at the hotel.







Badrinath Dham is located between the two mountains i.e. Nar and Narayan, Badrinath Dham or Badrinarayan temple is a holy shrine, dedicated to Lord Vishnu. The sacred temple is first among the four holiest Char Dham of India & prime among the Chota Char Dham of Uttarakhand. The majestic holy shrine is also one among the 108 Divya Desams dedicated to Lord Vishnu.

Mythological Significance: The mythology surrounding Shri Badrinath Temple is intricately woven with the legends of Lord Vishnu, particularly in his form as Badrinath, the preserver of the universe. According to Hindu mythology, Lord Vishnu meditated at this sacred spot for countless aeons, seeking penance to alleviate the sufferings of humanity. Impressed by his devotion, Lord Vishnu's consort, Goddess Lakshmi, assumed the form of a Badri tree (Indian Jujube) to provide him shade, hence the name Badrinath.















DAY 7: BADRINATH TO HARIDWAR

(Drive -540 Kms/12 Hrs Approx.)

- After breakfast, check-out from the hotel.
- Drive back to Haridwar.
- Drop-off at Haridwar Railway Station/Bus Stand.
